Building an Enduring Work!

TEXT: 1 Cor 3:10-23

The Apostle Paul was the one who planted the church in Corinth, (Acts 18). He was their spiritual father because he led many of them to Christ, (4:14-15). In accordance to the grace given him, Paul was sent to skillfully and masterfully build on the foundation of Jesus Christ. He established this church proclaiming the right message, in the power of the Spirit, so that the Corinthian's faith would rest on the power of God alone. This power is demonstrated in the preaching of the cross. Hence, Paul gives us a window to the keys of an enduring work!

- I. THE RIGHT KIND OF MASTER BUILDER: *Paul*, 3:10, cf. 2:1-5.

The pursuit of other foundations that leave the true foundation of "Jesus Christ and Him crucified" is dangerous.

POINT: God possesses all things! Christ, who is in God, also possesses all things. We, who are in Christ and belong to him, by extension possess all things. God is the ultimate reality and His wisdom is supreme. Outside of God, there lies nothing. Why then seek and debate about a wisdom or method *outside of God*, especially when Paul said that it will not eternally endure?
