Satan: An Instrument of God for Our Sanctification

TEXT: 1 Cor. 5:1-13

A Sovereign God uses Satan in the process of progressive sanctification.

I. THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD AND HIS CONTROL OVER THE CREATED ORDER

- A. God created all things and they exist for His Glory, Rev. 4:11.
- **B.** God *controls all things* and every event serves His purpose, Psa. 119:89; Isa. 46:9.
 - 1. God determines the length of man's life, Job 14:5; Dan. 5:23.
 - 2. God determines all governing authorities, Dan. 4:17, 25, 32; cf., Pro 21:1; Rom 13:1.

II. THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD AND HIS CONTROL OVER SATAN

- **A. Satan and the wicked are under God's control**, Pro. 16:4; Job 12:16; Psa. 76:10.
 - **1.** God controlled the evil acts of men involved in the death of His Son, John 9:10-11; Acts 2:22-23.
 - 2. God controls the final destiny of the Evil One, Rev 12, 13, 20.
 - a. Satan is cast out of heaven in Revelation 12.
 - b. With divine permission, Satan sets up the false kingdom in Revelation 13.

- 3. Satan will be divinely released at the end of the Millennial Kingdom to deceive the Nations of the Millennial Kingdom in Revelation 20.
- 4. Satan will ultimately be cast into the Lake of Fire, Rev 20:10.
- **B. Satan cannot touch God's child without divine permission**, Job 1:12; 2:6.

When God allows Satan to touch believers, it is for their sanctification.

III. THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD AND HIS CONTROL OVER THE SANCTIFYING PROCESS OF HIS CHILDREN, Rom. 8:28-30.

- A. God uses suffering to sanctify His children, Rom. 8:18-30.
- B. God allows Satan to bring about suffering to sanctify His Children, 1 Cor 5:5.
 - 1. Satan was the means under God's sovereign control to bring Job to repentance, Job 1:12; 2:6; cf. 42:6-7
 - 2. Paul turns Hymenaeus and Alexander over to Satan so that they would learn not to blaspheme, 1 Tim 1:20.
 - 3. The Lord sent a Messenger of Satan to keep Paul from exalting himself, 2 Cor 12:7-10.
 - 4. Paul decided to hand over the incestuous man to Satan, 5:5.

IV. APPLICATION

- A. God uses our greatest enemy to sanctify us.
- B. Even though sin is under God's control, it cannot be tolerated.
